Topic: We are growing in-vivo and in-vitro cartilage, cultured from autogenous chondrocytes. The cartilage is grown on a biodegradable template in various complex shapes, then reimplanted into the subject. Additional work with injectable cartilage using Fibrin sealants and growth factors. Specimen analysis includes viability, elasticity, tensile strength and durability unique to this engineered tissue. 1995-present
